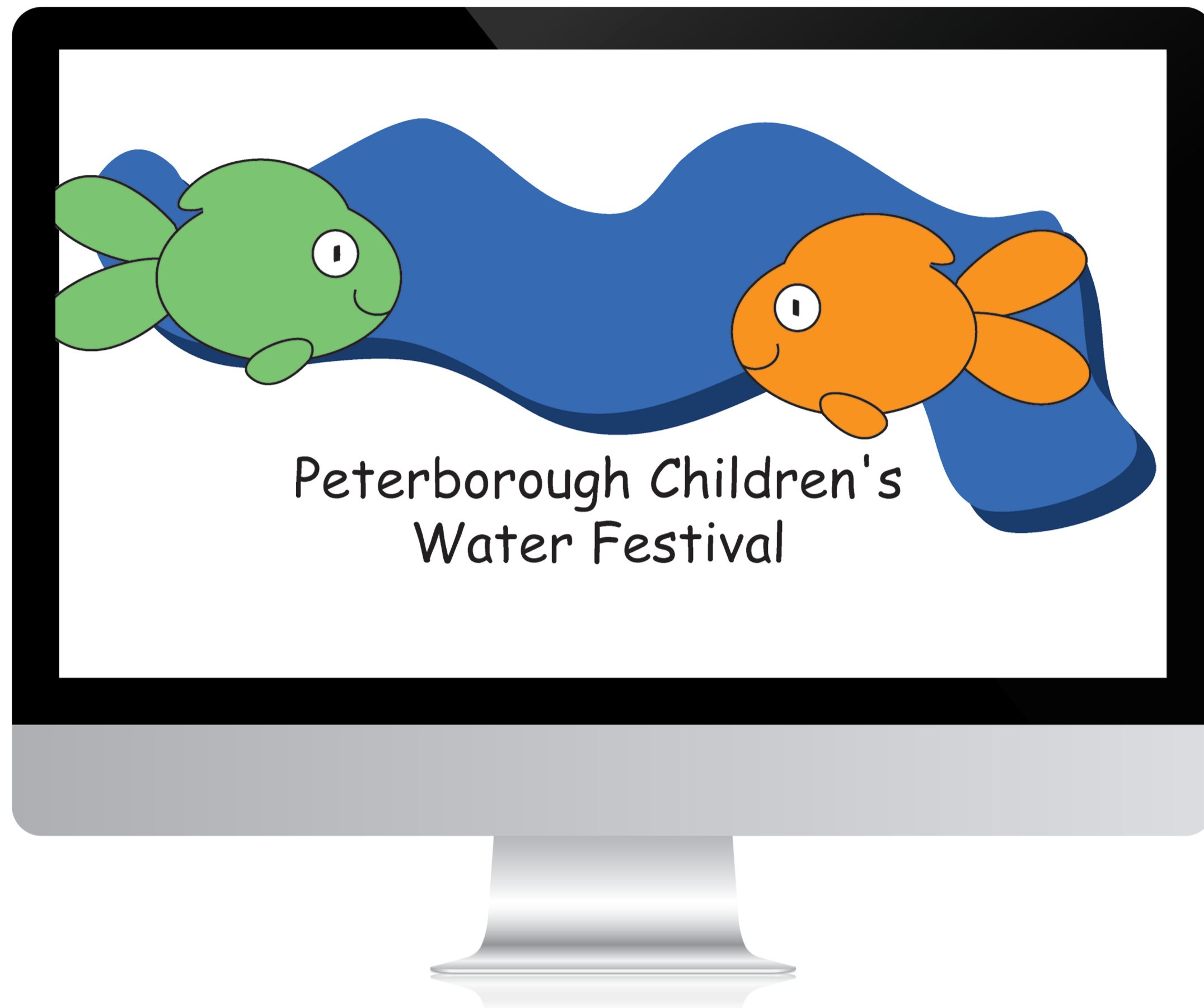

Water-based education flowing over 4 #WaterWednesday's



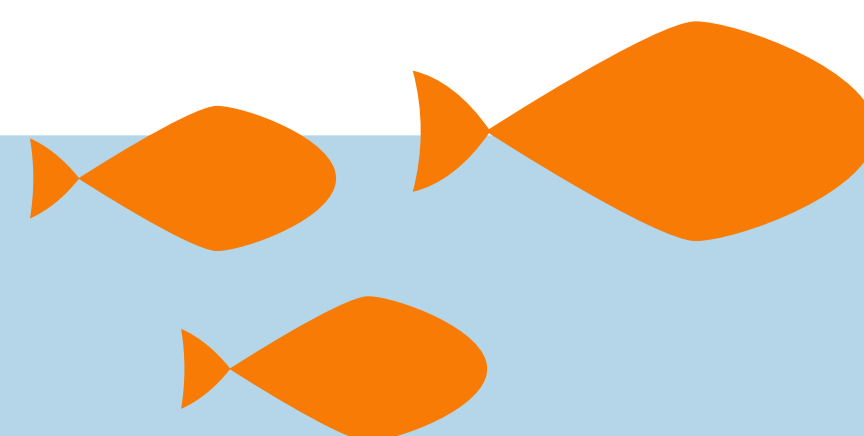
A total of 1478 students tuned in throughout the month of May



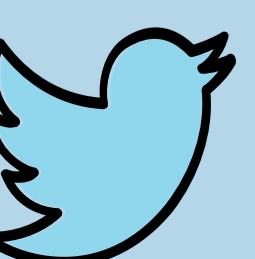
